3. Nature of the deed: Trust Deed.

4. A meeting of the Hon'ble members was held at Aaris Court residence of Sri Lipindra Panshra a Senior Advocate, on 09.10.88. presided over by Sri R.P. Jha to establish a Trust for the benefit of general mass specially to impart proper formal and informal modern education which has been very costly these days, to the children of the Society.

In the above meeting the following resolutions were passed and accepted:-

i. Name of the Trust: MODERN EDUCAT-

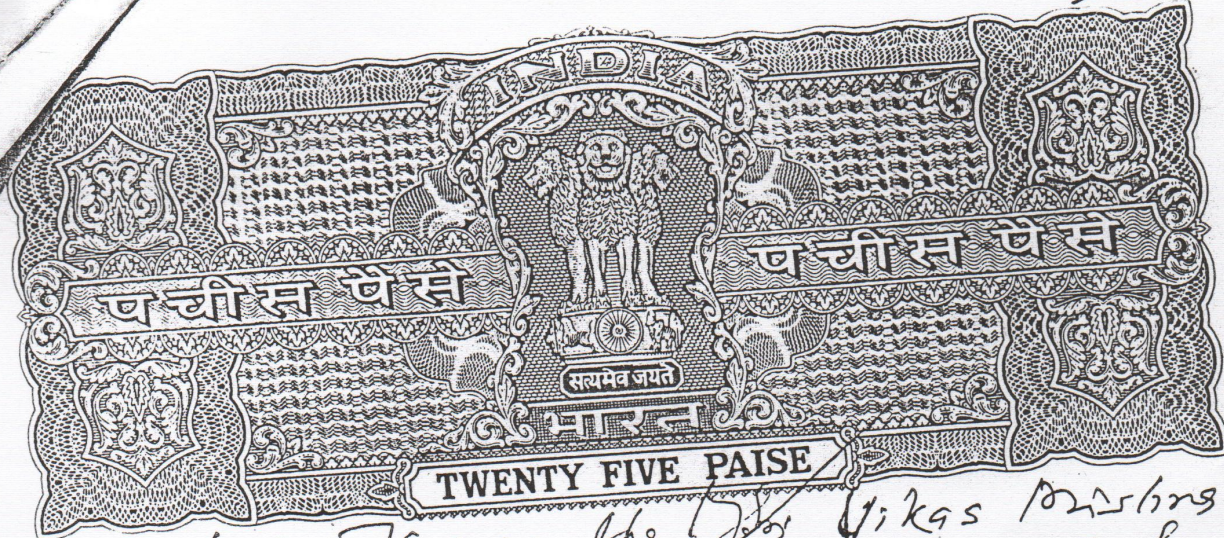


ii. Aims and Objects:- To raise such an institution which can provide education based on public school pattern on low cost to the children particularly of this Kosi ravaged socially and educationally backward region, to cope up with the present competitive life-tread without any feeling of Casteism, Communalism, religion, untouchability excluding politics.

Keeping in view the motto of the Trust, to initiate with, it was unanimously decided to raise a public school called Mithila Public School, at 2 P.O. Bhadrachwar, Distt. Araris.

5. Sri Upendra Mishra, Advocate Araris Court, resident of village Bhadrachwar has very kindly donated a piece of land having an area of 2 acres 7 decimals, Holding no. 201 Plot no. 1722, village Bhadrachwar, P.S. Jogbani, Distt. Araris to M.P.S. vide registration deed No. 6317 dated 12.5.89.

6. It has unanimously decided that to raise and run the proposed Mithila Public School having all the experiences of public school Mr. R. P. Jha

8. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS AND
MEMBERS: (a) will manage for a sum



Sum of Rs 25000/- Twenty five thousand to initiate the Trust and arrange for the money needed for raising the School on loan or the way he is capable of.

9. All the Admn., legal, judicial and financial power required for the establishment and smooth functioning of the school will be delegated to Mr. Vikas Mishra holding the post of Director Admn. He shall sue and may be sued on behalf of the institution.

10. Mr. Ambuj Kumar Jha and Mrs. Patal Mishra Principal and Vice Principal respectively will be responsible for academics and public relations.

11. It will be the joint effort and responsibility of the DA, principal and the vice principal to pay off all the loans, debts, raised and collected by the Chairman for the cause and benefit of the institution. No members other than the Chairman, Director Admn. principal and vice principal will be liable for the payment of any sort of loans or debts, related to the Trust of the School.



be holding independent Charges under direct control of the Chairman.

13. Maintenance and handling of accounts:-

A proper Bank Account of the Trust or the School shall be maintained with one of the local scheduled Banks. It will be jointly operated by the Chairman and DA or by the principal and the DA or by the DA and officiating principal in the absence of the principal. All the accounts shall be audited annually by authentic body Chartered Accountant. The audited statements of the accounts together with the audit report will be placed before the Board of Trustees for consideration, approval and comments. One copy of the same will be handed over to the Chairman for his perusal and final comment.

14. Though both the DA and the principal will be independent heads working directly under the control of the Chairman there must be co-operation and understanding among them for the benefit of the school.

It will be the responsibility of the principal/Secretary to call and hold the regular meeting and look after the education. It will also be the



- operate with him/ her his functioning. Like-
-wise the DA will be the financial incharge and maintain the administration of the school, to have proper check/control over any income and expenditure all the vouchers and memoes, and money related documents must be verified and countersigned by the DA and the Principal both, subjected to the Chairman's inspection.

15. Appointment of any staff members and their pay and allowances will be decided by the Chairman, with the assistance of the Principal and the DA. However the CBSE pay scale will be given to the teaching and non teaching staff once the income of the school will be increased to the required standard.

16. Efforts will be made to appoint qualified teachers and non-teaching staff. However in case of non availability of the qualified teaching staff the non qualified but experienced and intelligent teachers will be appointed with the condition that the teachers so employed will achieve their requisite qualification during the period of two years after the affiliation of



17. During initial stage of the school, appointment of the teaching and non-teaching staff will be made on adhoc basis and only adhoc pay as under will be given to them. P.F. etc. will not be made till such time as the affiliation of the school is done. Till then the following pay scale for the teaching and non teaching staff is fixed as below:-

18. As decided, the fee and other reasonable charges will be charged from the students. However the school authority is empowered to increase or decrease the same according to the ~~circumstances~~ circumstances and thought of the local public in consultation with the Board of Governors.

19. As all the credit and discredit



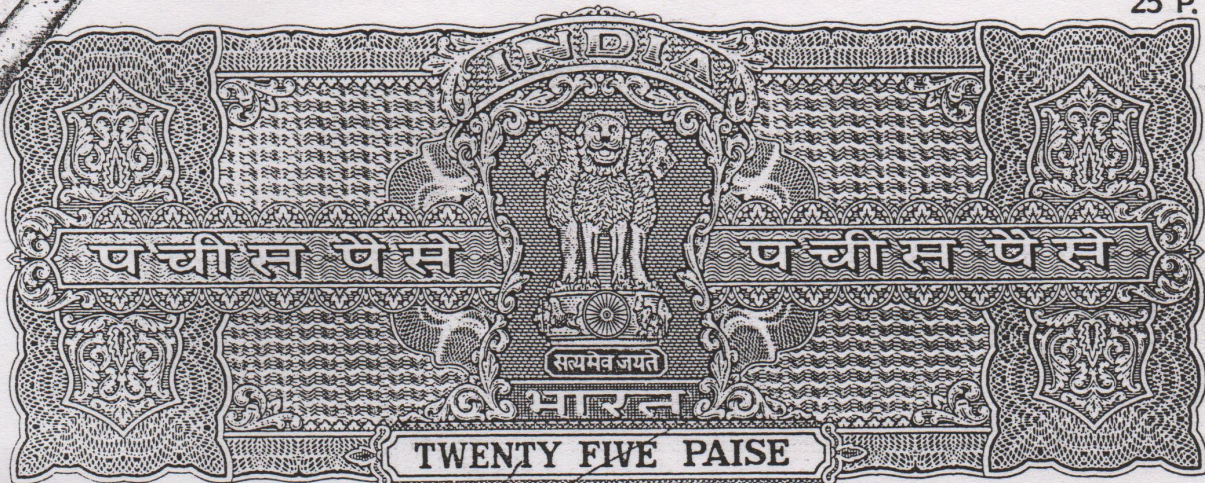
- of running the school will go to the head of the Chairman, the Chairman will be the final authority in all regards. There shall not be any financial, inner or outside interference in the mode of the Chairman's working style.
20. If the chairman will be out of station for long period for any reason, the Vice Chairman will look after and guide the school on the written request of the Chairman.
21. The Chairman shall not take any salary but he must get a Subsistence allowance approved by the Board of Governors and the institution must be responsible for his and his wife's welfare till survival.
22. At least five members of the Board of Governors shall form the quorum of the meeting.
23. God forbid, due to any mishap, if the school ceases to function all the dues and liabilities should be cleared off disposing the assets of the school off.



24. I hope the Chairman shall be the supreme head of the Trust and the school he shall have to seek the approval of the Board of Governors on all the vital actions taken in his part and he will be free to act as likes for the betterment of the institution. The Chairman may cease and cancell the portfolio of any office bearer on misappropriation and misuse of his rights and duties with the approval of the Board.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

25. The Trust shall be administered by a Board consisting of not less than five and not more than fifteen Trustees of which the above mentioned five members namely Sri R. B. Gha, Sri Upendra Mishra, Sri Anbuji K. Gha, Sri Vikas Mishra and Smt. Binita Mishra will be treated as first Trustees and remaining trustees will be nominated Trustees from amongst the men of integrity and men interested in welfare and philanthropic works. These Trustees will be known as nominated Trustees by the first Trustee adopting some criteria. However any gentlemen or lady may be accepted.



of Governors of the School if he or she willingly pay donate a sum of Rs 50,000/- fifty thousand and above for the welfare of the institution.

26. The Trustees shall not function if at any time their number is less than five say for the purpose of appointing such member of the Trust as shall make up the deficiency.

27. In the event of first Trustees ceasing to be Trustee the remaining trustees shall be entitled to appoint any person of their choice to fill the vacancy. Such a Trustee for all purposes shall be regarded as a Trustee nominated by the first Trustees.

28. Before assuming office or taking part in any meeting a newly appointed Trustee shall give his consent in writing to act as such Trustee.

29. A Trustee will cease to be Trustee in any of the following events,
(a) If he dies.



- (c) If he becomes insolvent, insane or otherwise incapable to act.
- (d) If he resigns by his own sweet will.
- (e) If he leaves the Country for good or ceases to be the Citizen of the Country.

30. (a) At least two meetings in a year the Board of Trustees will be held in the Campus.

(b) Notice of the meeting of the Trustees and all other Communications will be sent to the Trustees by their respective addresses under registered post along with the agenda of the meetings.

(c) Fifteen days notice shall be given for any meeting of the Trustees.

(d) Every Trustees shall have one vote in any meeting and the decision of the Board shall be by the majority. In case equality of vote the Chairman will have casting vote.
